While reading each chapter, write down a few important points from each in preparation for the Bullet Point Summary assignment in Module 3.

Writing

You can submit your writing assignments by emailing Jay Street (jays@gbcob.org) a Word or PDF doc, or by printing a hardcopy and turning it in on Sunday morning at the BTI welcome table.

Every paper (e.g., Bible Book Review, Essay, etc.) should be formatted accordingly:

- ✓ Double-spaced
- ✓ 12-point Times New Roman font
- ✓ 1" margins
- ✓ Title (cover page is optional)
- ✓ Your first and last name

You will write Bible Book Reviews for these Bible books in this module:

- ✓ Genesis
- ✓ Exodus
- ✓ Leviticus
- ✓ Numbers
- ✓ Deuteronomy

1–2 pages for each Bible Book Review

A Bible Book Review should include the following information:

- ✓ **WHO:** Discuss the author and audience of the book.
- ✓ **WHEN:** Discuss the date of authorship of the book.
- ✓ **WHERE:** Discuss the location of the book's author and location of the audience at the time of writing, as well as the historical setting.
- ✓ **WHY:** Discuss the purpose of the book as written to the original audience.
- ✓ **HOW:** Provide a basic outline of the book and a few major themes.
- ✓ Optional: Any other interesting features in the book that you learned in the lectures or your own reading or study of the book.

Inspiration and Inerrancy Essay

Explain the doctrines of Inspiration and Inerrancy.

3–5 pages

Theology Proper Essay

Write an essay explaining as if to an unbeliever all the concepts about Theology Proper you have learned about the nature of God.

5–10 pages

Spiritual Impact Essay

Write an essay indicating 3–5 ways you were spiritually impacted this semester.

2 pages

Though a cumulative submission of all assignments in a module will no longer be required, I advise that you keep all your BTI lecture notes and written assignments organized in one secure location for your own future reference and study. Your written work should be accessible for you so that, upon request, it would be no trouble for you to access and submit them as one cumulative project.

Schedule
