Writing

Every paper (e.g., Bible Book Review, Essay, etc.) should be formatted accordingly:

- ✓ Double-spaced
- ✓ 12-point Times New Roman font
- ✓ 1" margins
- ✓ Title (cover page is optional)
- ✓ Your first and last name

- You will write Bible Book Reviews for these Bible books in this module:
 - ✓ Proverbs
 - ✓ Song of Songs
 - ✓ Ecclesiastes
 - ✓ Obadiah, Joel, Jonah, Amos, Hosea, Micah (all one Bible Book Review)
 - ✓ Isaiah
 - ✓ Nahum, Zephaniah, Habakkuk (all one Bible Book Review)

1–2 pages for each Bible Book Review

A Bible Book Review should include the following information:

- ✓ **WHO:** Discuss the author and audience of the book.
- ✓ **WHEN:** Discuss the date of authorship of the book.
- ✓ **WHERE:** Discuss the location of the book's author and location of the audience at the time of writing, as well as the historical setting.
- ✓ **WHY:** Discuss the purpose of the book as written to the original audience.
- ✓ **HOW:** Provide a basic outline of the book and a few major themes.
- ✓ **Optional:** Any other interesting features in the book that you learned in the lectures or your own reading or study of the book.

Hamartiology Essay

Explain the concepts of Original Sin, the Problem of Sin, and Total Depravity. Just a brief overview of these with scriptural support.

2–4 pages

Disciplines of a Godly Man (men) or *Disciplines of a Godly Woman* (women)
Bullet Point Summary

Provide a few bullet points from each chapter summarizing some key points. Bullet point summaries should be concise (just a few words); complete sentences not required.

1–3 pages

Spiritual Impact Essay

Write an essay indicating 3–5 ways you were spiritually impacted this semester.

2 pages

Though a cumulative submission of all assignments in a module will no longer be required, I advise that you keep all your BTI lecture notes and written assignments organized in one secure location for your own future reference and study. Your written work should be accessible for you so that, upon request, it would be no trouble for you to access and submit them as one cumulative project.

Activity

Prayer

On two separate occasions, spend time in prayer for your unsaved family members and opportunities to share the gospel.

Gospel Tracks / Gospel Discussions

Give away 3–25 Gospel Tracks and interact with any willing to engage with you
OR

Have at least 3 conversations with one (or more) person(s) whom you are not sure as to his/her salvation and minister the Word of God and the gospel to him/her. Write a one-page (double-spaced) summary of your interaction with him/her.
